HOW SHOULD THIS RESULTS REPORT INFORMATION BE USED?

Nurses who pass the examination will use the information in their results report to determine the content areas in which professional development points must be earned in order to renew certification in four years, using the Individual Learning Needs Assessment (ILNA) option.

For instance, if 10 ILNA Points are required in Psychosocial Dimensions of Care in the Performance Summary graph, you would earn 10 ILNA professional development points related to psychosocial care of the patient with cancer through the completion of continuing education, academic education, publications, or presentations prior to your certification expiration date and application submission deadline. You will add these points to your online learning plan through LearningBuilder.

WHAT IS ILNA?

ILNA requires that certified nurses earn professional development points in activities such as continuing education (CNE or CME), academic education, publications or presentations in the specific content areas defined by their performance on the certification examination (first cycle) or an online assessment (subsequent cycles).

The number of ILNA points required is based on the weighting of each category and the nurse's performance on each content category of the certification examination. Within the four-year certification period, the certified nurse will be required to attain and document the specified number of professional development points in the required content areas to renew certification. One ILNA point is equivalent to one hour of continuing education.

For certified nurses who do not wish to use ILNA, there are two other options for certification renewal: 1) retake and pass the certification examination prior to credential expiration or 2) provide documentation of earning 100 professional development points, distributed among all content areas of the test content outline in the percentages indicated in the blueprint. Certified nurses who wish to earn 100 points in all content areas will need to request a 100-point learning plan from ONCC. These earned points will still be documented and submitted via the learning plan.

WHEN CAN I EARN ILNA POINTS?

Certified nurses may begin to collect ILNA points through professional development activities from the date they pass the examination until the date that the learning plan and renewal application are submitted.
